Silent Auction Rules

Welcome to Gourmets for God 2011.

This fundraiser for the Center for Spiritual Living brings together members of our church community, as well as friends and family, to meet, eat and raise money.

We have gathered over 70 hosts who are putting on every imaginable form of culinary entertainment. Now you have the opportunity to bid on the chance to attend one or more of these fabulous events.

All the events take place between Jun 2011 - Dec 2011. During the four Sundays of our silent auction, you will be able to bid on as many meals as you like. The auction items will be open for bidding on Sundays, from 8:30 am - 12:30 pm in the CSL lobby. Assume Smoking - no, Handicap accessible - no unless otherwise stated in the item information. And we also have the new option of bidding online through our website! Visit SpiritualLiving.MaestroWeb.com or SpiritualLiving.org/Gourmets

The *'In Lobby'* bidding works like this:

Let's say a host offers a chicken barbecue for ten people with a starting bid of \$25. You bid by signing up on the bidding sheet. After ten people have each bid \$25, the eleventh person can still be on the guest list by placing a higher bid. This will bump the lowest bidder, *the one that was last to bid*, off the guest list.

Keep checking the bidding sheet—if you were outbid and you want to ensure your seat at the barbecue, you counter with an even higher bid. In the end, the highest ten bidders will have bought tickets to the meal. All that's left to do is show up at the appointed time and place for a great time and great food. In the case of a tie, the earlier bidder wins. *NOTE: As you've probably figured out, it's a smart strategy to put your bids in early for the events you want to attend!*

The fine print:

1. Your bid is a contract. Please do not bid if you cannot attend.
2. You must register to receive a bidding number. Bidding without one will void your bid. Volunteers at the auction registration table will explain the financial guidelines for participating in the auction.
3. Each bidder must bid on a separate line. If you want to attend as a couple or family, please use a separate line for each person and bracket your names so we know to keep you together. Some hosts have agreed to take one additional person to avoid splitting up a couple.
4. When you are raising a bid, please raise by the suggested increment or more for that event. Most events raise by a minimum of \$2 (Standard event) or others raise by a \$5 minimum (Premium event).
5. If you find you have been outbid and you would like to keep bidding, please put your name and bid number on a new line with your new, higher bid. Do not erase and change your original bid (or bids).
6. If you win an auction but then find you are unable to attend, you may gift or resell your spot to a friend or family member. No refunds will be given.
7. All proceeds from the *Gourmets for God* auction benefit the Center for Spiritual Living.

That's it! Have fun! Eat well! Bid early and bid often!

The online auction will end at 9pm on Sunday, May 29. Each item is a unique "seat" at the featured event. Within the online auction, the highest bid at 9pm on May 29th is the winner for that "seat". Your high bid is your agreement to purchase that seat.

Things to know about registering as a bidder:

- Your bidder number is unique to you. You will use the same number for online and in person bidding.
- Registering as a bidder does not obligate you to make a purchase. You will only be invoiced if you are a winning bidder.
- If you receive emails from Center for Spiritual Living on a regular basis, you already exist in the data base. However, you do not become an active bidder until you complete the registration process. You will be asked to enter your credit card information.

Activate Your Registration

Activating your registration allows you to bid on items, add items to your wish list, send emails to friends - inviting them to bid with you, and track your bids.

Track the items you are interested in and you'll know where you end up in the online bidding. The online auction ends 9pm on Sunday, May 29. Each item is a unique "seat" at the featured event. Within the online auction, the highest bid at 9pm on May 29th is the winner for that "seat".

The in lobby auction will continue for one more week and concludes on June 5th. If you missed out on getting a place at an event --- make sure to be present Sunday, June 5th for final opportunity to get a coveted seat!

You can also type in a search word for example; chocolate, vegan or barbeque in the search field within the tool bar in the upper left of black band at the top of our Silent Auction home page.

Click on any month in the Black Side Bar on the left.

This will take you to the Gourmets for God events.

When you find something you absolutely must have (or at least bid on!): Follow the instructions on the Silent Auction Home Page (to get back

there click on the Home tab in the black tool bar at the top of the page) to register as a bidder.

To activate your account,
simply *click Sign In then...* See pic below!

1. Click on **Find Existing Record** on the bottom of the Sign-In Page.
2. Enter your First Name, Last Name, the Numbers of your Street Address (or any numbers), your email address (or made up email) and click on **Find My Record**. Your record should pop up with a request to Update Record. **At this point, verify your information and enter your password**, which will be unique to this secure site.
3. Click on **Update Record** at the bottom of the screen.

Next you will be popped back to the Silent Auction home page.

Look at the upper left corner of the window and you should see the message: Welcome _____ (Your Name)! in red in the upper left of the window.
